Dear Parents or Guardians,

Welcome to the Liberty Public Schools Summer School Program for Kellybrook Elementary. We are excited about the opportunity to work with your child in the coming weeks.

The first day of Summer School is Monday, June 5, and ends on June 29. There will be no school on Monday, June 19th in observance of Juneteenth. Each school day will begin at 8:00 a.m. and conclude at 2:35 p.m.

All students in grades K-5 have been placed in a homeroom class depending on the grade level they will be entering next year. Your child will be using a curriculum that will provide your child with exciting, hands-on simulations and activities to enhance his/her literacy development in the areas of reading, writing, spelling, listening, and speaking as well as math content. Students will be provided a 25-minute lunch period and two recesses; one 15-minute and one 30-minute. Specials classes will also be offered K-5 similar to the school year. The classes are titled; EArt Explorations, Music Explorations, and PE. Your child's teacher will send you the specials rotation on the first day of summer adventure.

**Transportation:**

It is important that your child has a regular and consistent method of transportation to and from school. Make sure that your child knows how he/she is to go home from summer school, and if possible keep that method the same for all the days of summer school. Your child should know if he/she is going to the Kid's Zone Program after school, a walker, a car rider, or a bus rider. If your child will ride the bus, he/she needs to know the bus number. If you have transportation questions, please call 736-5360.

If you need to change your child's normal method of transportation, a written note or a telephone call is needed ***before 2:05 p.m.*** ***If the school does not receive a notice from a parent, your child will be sent home as his/her normal transportation method.***

**Car riders**

Our school day is 8:00AM – 2:35 PM. Children may enter the building at 7:45 AM. We ask those children being dropped off by car exit the vehicle at the curb from the passenger side of the vehicle starting at 7:45. Drivers are asked to stay in the vehicle to help the car line move smoothly. We will have 2 car rider lines. Students with last names beginning with A-L will unload at the curb on the east side of the building from 7:45 – 8:00 AM, and students with last names beginning with M-Z will unload at the curb at the north entrance from 7:45 – 8:00 AM. **Please encourage children to get out of the car by themselves to keep the lines moving.**

**Buses**

Bus traffic will flow through the south parking lot. Staff members will be there to greet students in the AM and then dismiss in the afternoon.

### **Walkers**

108<sup>th</sup> street walkers will use the back doors next to the playground. 106<sup>th</sup> street walkers will use the bus doors to enter the building. There will be adult supervision in these areas in the AM and PM for safety.

### **Snacks**

In an effort to promote the health and safety of all of our students during Summer Adventure, it is important to have an increased awareness of the many students with life-threatening food allergies. In order to reduce accidental exposure to peanuts, tree nuts, and other allergens, **we are asking that students refrain from bringing snacks.** If special arrangements need to be made, please consult the summer session nurse. Students who are celebrating birthdays in the summer are encouraged to celebrate with non-food items.

### **Medication/Nurse**

A nurse will be on staff at Kellybrook for the summer school program. If your child has any medical conditions or needs to take medication at school, please share this information with the summer school nurse and your child's teachers to help ensure the safety of your son or daughter.

### **Lunch/Breakfast**

Breakfast and lunch will be full pay this summer. There will also be snacks available to purchase. Breakfast and lunch will be eaten in the cafeteria. Students will need to know their PIN number if they are purchasing a meal from the cafe. Kindergarten students will be given theirs by their classroom teacher.

### **School Supplies**

Please send pencils, a notebook, and a backpack with your child to summer school. All other supplies will be provided.
