Dear Parents/ Guardians,

We are eager to have your child in our classrooms this summer and we want to share some information with you so your child will have a successful month! Below you will find a list of supplies your child will need and on the back is an outline of a typical day in Kindergarten Summer School.

We are very excited about our summer school curriculum! It has been generated by a group of Liberty early-childhood teachers and is designed to prepare your child for a full day of Kindergarten in the fall. The curriculum is literature-based and focuses on classroom awareness, community building and problem solving with peers and adults! To make this experience successful, **please send the following supplies with your child:**

- A beach towel or blanket for rest time (please be sure that it is labeled with your child's name!)
Please no stuffed animals or pillows
- Backpack (regular sized and no rollers please!) **Bring this every day!**
- Please send a pair of extra clothing with undergarments in your child's backpack daily because all kinds of accidents happen in kindergarten (lunch spills, art activities, etc.)
- Please bring the following:

*1-2 packages of Play-Doh

*4 pack glue sticks

*1 24-pack of Crayola Crayons

*1 box of Kleenex OR 1 role of paper towels OR 1 package of wet wipes

*1 Take Home Folder

Certain snack limitations may be necessary if food allergies are present in the classroom or grade level. Your Kindergarten teacher will provide you with any snack limitations before the first day of school. Please plan to send your child to school each day with one healthy snack for our afternoon snack time.

11:25-11:50	Lunch Restroom Break
11:50-12:05	Drinks and Read Aloud
12:05-12:20	Letter of the Day
12:20-1:10	Specials
1:10-1:30	Rest/Reflection Time Rest/reflection time will give your child the opportunity to relax while listening to soft music, as well as prepare for a great afternoon.
1:30-1:55	Snack Math Number, Shape, and Pattern Concepts
1:55-2:25	Discovery time Free-choice center play
2:25-2:35	Pack Up/Share/Dismissal
