Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the Liberty Public Schools 2023 summer school program at Shoal Creek Elementary. We are excited about the opportunity to work with your child in the coming weeks. The first day of summer school is Monday, June 5th and will conclude Thursday, June 29th. ***There will be no school on Monday, June 19th.*** Each school day will begin at 8:00 a.m. and conclude at 2:35 p.m. Students can begin entering the building at 7:45 a.m. and will be dismissed starting at 2:25 p.m.

All students in grades 1-5 have been placed in a core classroom depending on the grade level they will be entering next year. During the core class, your child will be using a curriculum that will provide them with exciting, hands-on simulations and activities to enhance his/her literacy and math development. All classrooms will have two recess times as well as 50 minutes of specials which will rotate between art, PE, and music.

**Supplies:** We are asking that all K-5 students bring 1 spiral notebook, a folder, and 2 pencils to use during summer school. Students in grades 1st-5th will also need a deck of playing cards for math games and markers. These do not have to be new markers. They can bring the markers from this past school year.

**Transportation:** It is important that your child has a regular and consistent method of transportation to and from school. Make sure that your child knows how he/she is to go home from summer school, and, if possible, keep that method the same for all the days of summer school. Your child should know if he/she is going to the Kid's Zone program after school, a car rider, a walker, or a bus rider. If your child will ride the bus, he/she needs to know the bus number. If you have transportation questions, please call 736-5360.

If you need to change your child's normal method of transportation a written note, email, or a telephone call to the Shoal Creek office (736-7150) is needed ***before 1:00 p.m.*** If the school does not receive notice from a parent, your child will be sent home as his/her normal transportation method.

As always, the safety of our students is our top priority. We will have staff present to assist with drop-off and pick-up each day. **We will allow parents to walk their child into school on the first day of summer school only. If you are walking your student into the building, please make sure you find a parking spot or park next door at the Woodneath library. Please do not block the car rider lines.** We ask that you help your child by letting them know that Shoal Creek teachers and staff will be outside to greet your child and welcome them to school as well as help get them to their classrooms every morning.

**\*Note: For kindergarten students only, LPS Staff will NOT release Kindergarten students without an adult present for walkers and bus riders.**

**Bus Riders:** Bus Riders will arrive each morning in the front bus loop where SC staff will be there to greet them and help get them to their classrooms. Afternoon bus riders will also load buses in the same area with staff members ensuring that students get on the correct bus.

**Walkers:** Students who are walking home from summer school will be grouped and escorted to the Woodneath neighborhood crosswalk by the pool. **Parents or guardians can meet their children there at 2:25 each afternoon.** We ask that you do not park your car in front of the crosswalk as this makes our dismissal unsafe with limited views. Thank you for your understanding.

**Car Riders:** During summer school, we will be utilizing **two car lots for arrival and dismissal.** We ask that you drop off your child anywhere in the white drop-off zone to keep traffic flowing (see picture below). Staff will be placed along the sidewalk to greet all students and get them safely to their classroom. Please use the picture as a guide for the traffic flow. **You may drop off your child starting at 7:45am and we will start loading afternoon car riders in their car starting at 2:25 each afternoon.**

#### **Woodneath Lot**

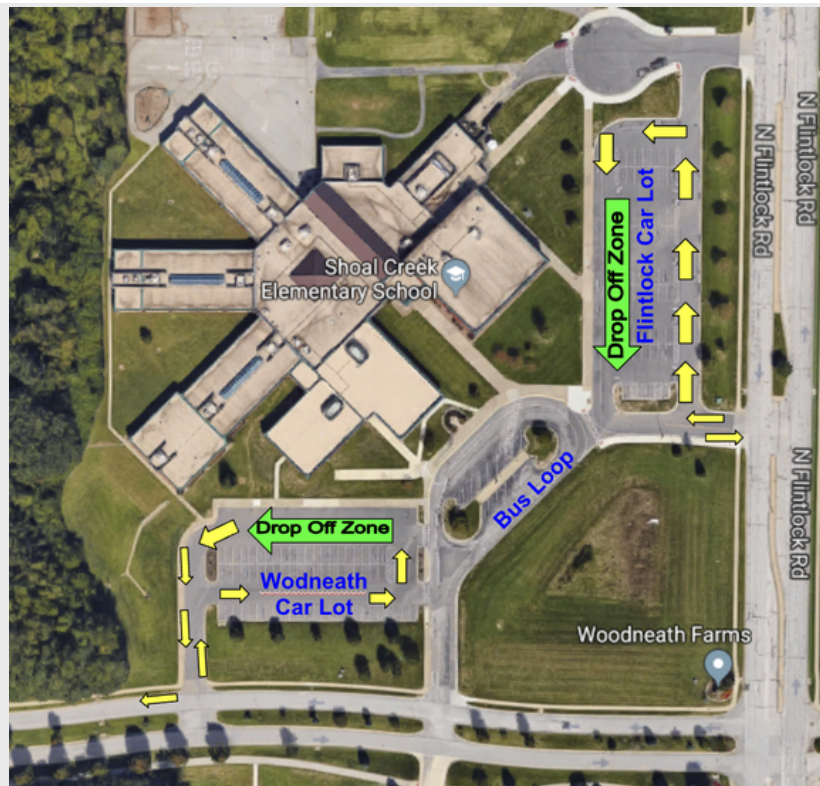
Car riders using the Woodneath lot need to use the westernmost entrance on 90th street when entering and exiting the lot. Upon entering the lot, turn right and follow the painted markings around the loop. Students will be dropped off at the curb near the building. When exiting the lot, **cars must turn right.** The right turn only was made in an effort to increase safety for our students and decrease the overall time necessary to travel through the car rider loop.

#### **Flintlock Lot**

Car riders using the Flintlock lot will use the southernmost entrance/exit off of Flintlock.

Upon entering the lot, turn right and follow the painted marking around the loop. For everyone's safety, it is important to keep cars off of Flintlock. Please start a double line when traffic starts backing up. Students will be dropped off at the curb nearest the front entrance to the building.

We respectfully request that you refrain from parking in the lot and walking your child into the building, as both lots will have heavy traffic flow. If you need to help your child buckle-up before leaving the lot, please pull over and park in a parking spot in order to keep the car lot traffic moving. Thanks for your cooperation.



**Medication/Nurse:** A nurse will be on staff at Shoal Creek for the summer school program. If your child has any medical conditions or needs to take medication at school, please share this information with the summer school nurse and your child’s teachers to help ensure the safety of your son or daughter. **Snacks & Water:** If you want to send your child with a daily snack, we ask that you make sure it is peanut-free for our students with allergies. Please make sure your child has a water bottle daily.

**Lunch:** Lunch will be available for purchase for \$2.70 per student lunch.

*Students already approved for free and reduced meals for 2022-23 will be automatically approved for summer school and into the first 30 days of the 2023-2024 school year. - Students may purchase a lunch or bring one from home and they will eat in the cafeteria.

- Allergies will be handled in the same way as during the school year. We do not operate allergen-free buildings but rather use safety procedures to protect all students. All allergies are tracked using our

computer software system, no need to resubmit forms unless a student has a new diagnosis or not yet in the system. Breakfast selections will be monitored by our nutrition staff. Sharing of food is prohibited.
