You may have seen earlier today that the Missouri Attorney General's office posted on social media that he has filed lawsuits against several school districts in Missouri, including LPS, stating the need to eliminate several COVID-19 mitigation efforts currently in schools. We will be working closely with our legal counsel to navigate the matter.
