### REQUIRED EQUIPMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS

- ✓ Each student should have a pencil with them every day. Keep this in your case.
- ✓ All students should have a good case for their instrument. Repair or replace any instrument case that does not work properly (this includes latches.)
- ✓ All instruments should be easy to tune and stay in tune.
- ✓ All instruments should be professionally set up (correct bridge/nut height).
- ✓ All instruments cases must have a nametag on them.
