1. Instrument: a quality, district-approved instrument

Recommended brands: Giuseppe, Eastman, Amati, Knilling, Glaesel, Scherl & Roth, KC Series, Wyatt brands, Canonici

Please do not invest in Cecelio, Mendini, or non-wood colored bows or instruments

*** Also, **no** colored instruments or bows please***

2. Book: Essential Elements 2000 Book 1

3. Folding Music Stand: needed for in-class rehearsals, in-home practice, and performances

3. Instrument Identification Tag: clearly marked with name, address, and phone number

4. Pencil: for recording practice and class assignments

5. Rosin: (Basses need “POPS” Bass Rosin)

6. Cleaning Cloth: covers the instrument when in the case and used for cleaning following playing. Items you have at home that will work: thin washcloth or bandana.

7. Shoulder Rest (Violin and Viola ONLY)

a) Everest or Kun shoulder rest (collapsible recommended)

b) Plastic container (preferably a school box/shoulder rest case) to protect the shoulder rest when it is not being used

8. Endpin Rest (Cello and Bass ONLY) - keeps instruments from slipping on the floor. Preferably an anchored strap endpin rest.

9. Cloth Music Bag: for transporting supplies
